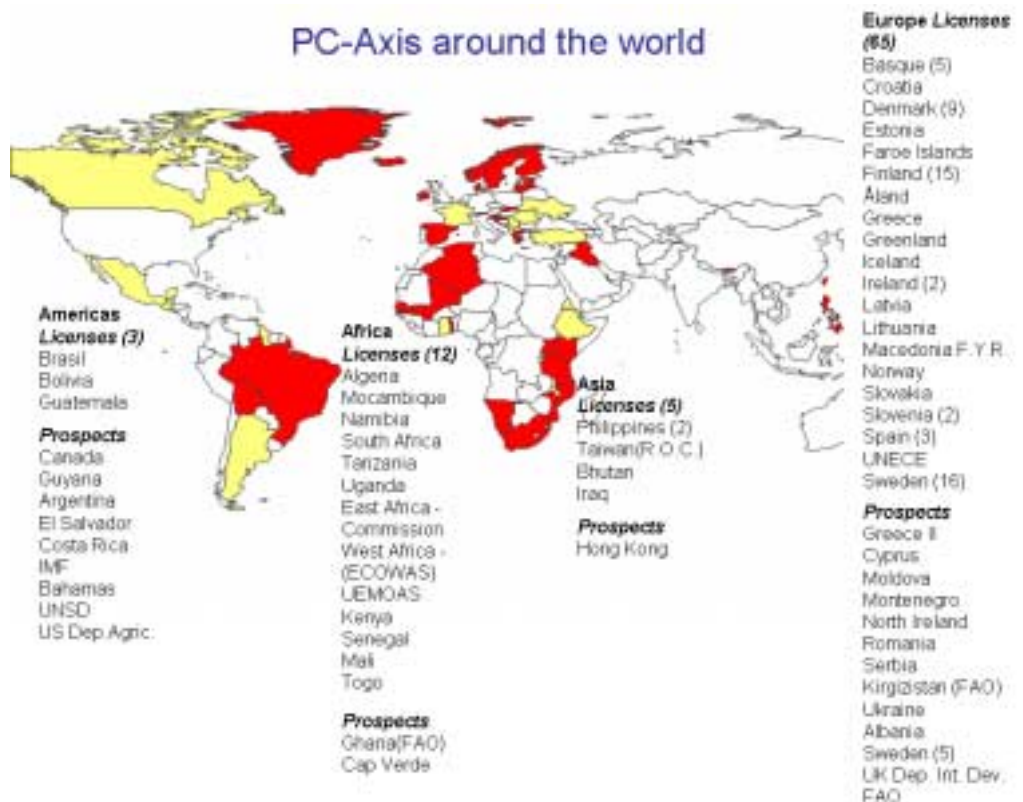


Report on experiences 2007 at Statistics Sweden with PC-Axis

The Lotta Project

Statistics Sweden has initiated a massive change of the organisation of work in a mega project named the Lotta Project. The Lotta Project consists of a lot of small projects that all are focused to make Statistics Sweden a process oriented organisation. All projects must not exceed 3 months in length. All personnel must participate in a Lotta sub project if they have been appointed. The poorest part of the organisation in the sense of a process orientation using standard tools is the data input, but also the metadata part is of high priority as well as the archive. A lot of resources have been devoted to these processes. One of the processes already using standard tools is for the output database where PC-Axis is an important part. For that reason also the dot.net conversion of PC-Axis has been appointed to be a Lotta sub project but not with the highest priority. That means that Petros Likidis has not had the chance to work much on PC-Axis until the end of July 2007 when the Lotta sub project for PC-Axis is started.

The development is divided into two Steps as two Lotta sub projects. Step 1 will start in end of July and end in November, Step 2 will start in January 2008 and end in March 2008.
