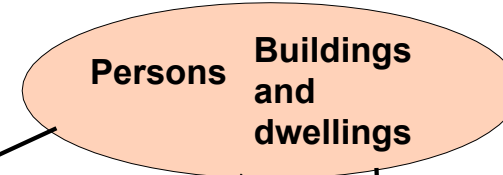

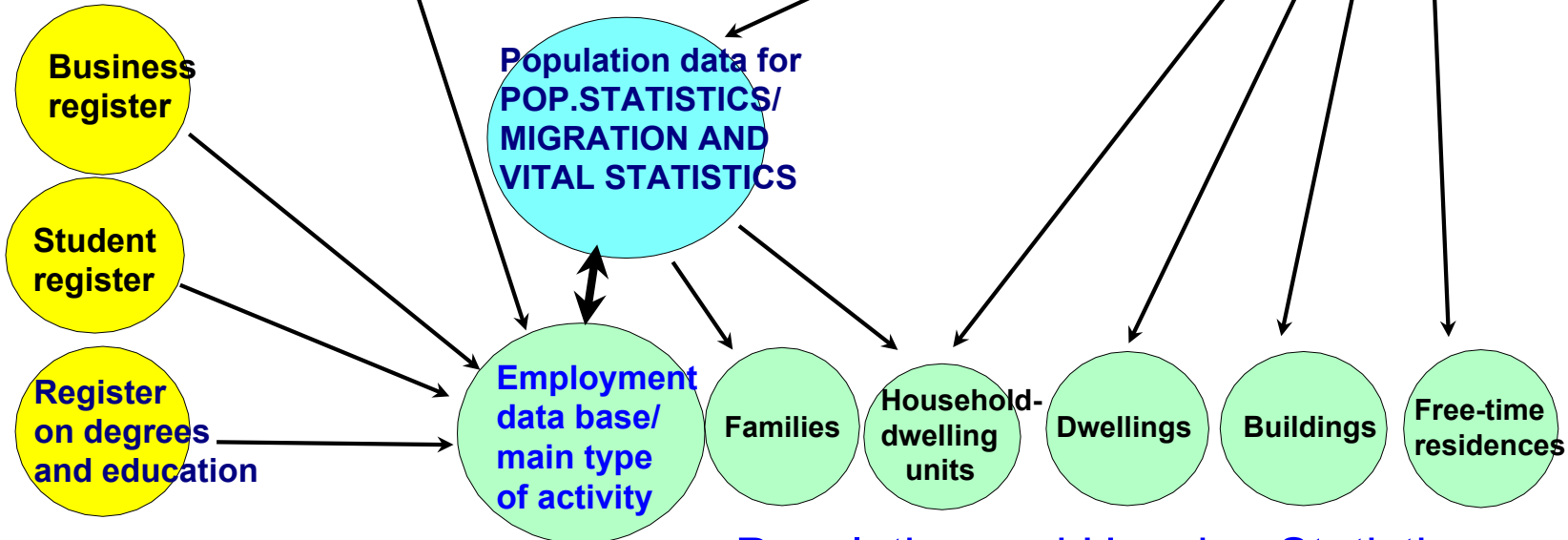

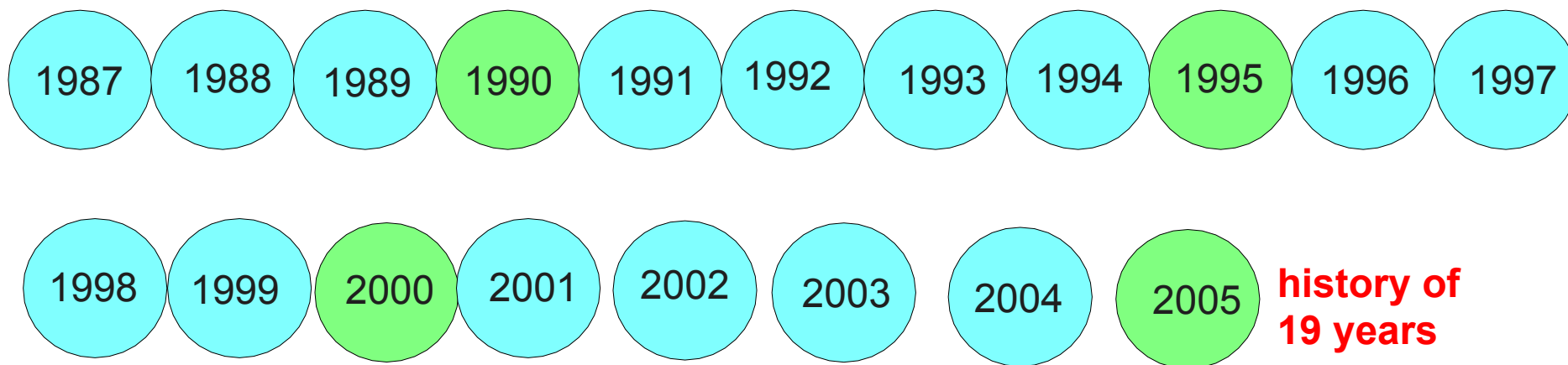

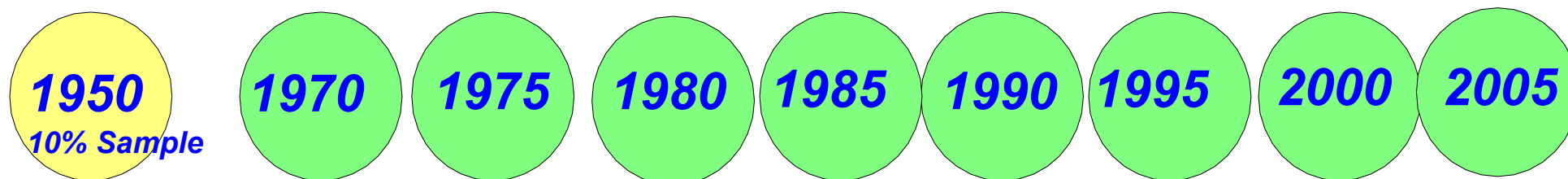
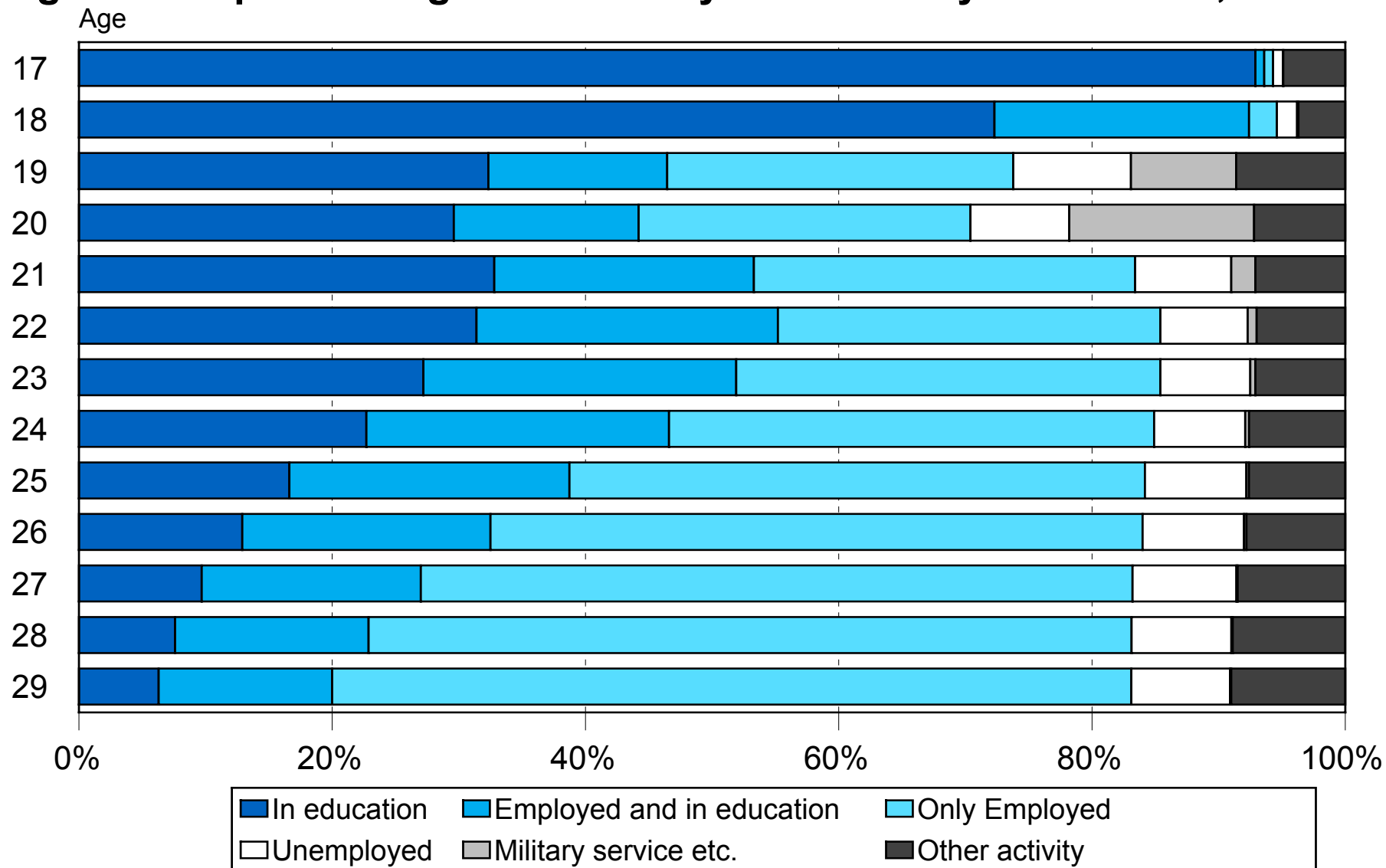




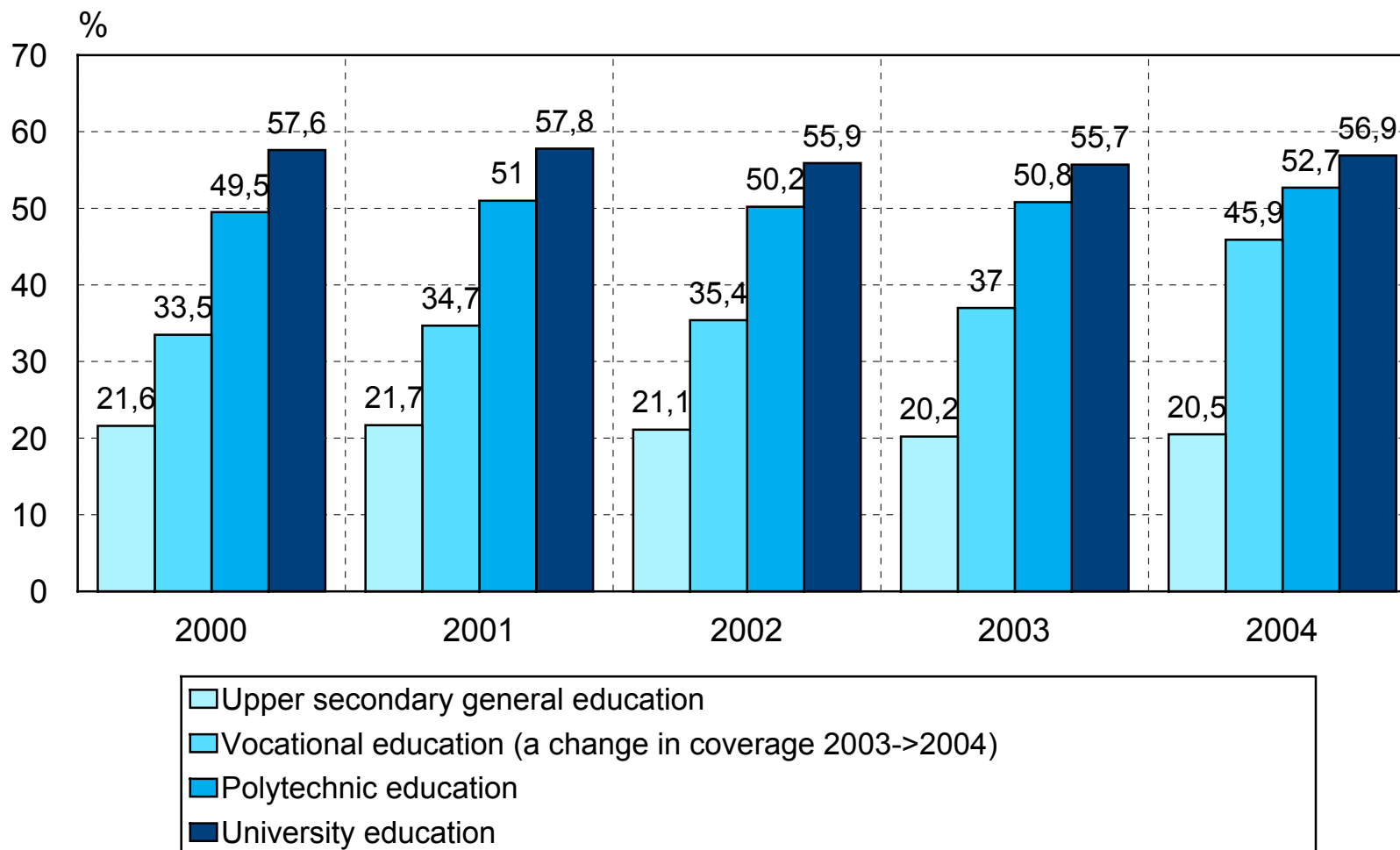


Figure 3. Population aged 17 to 29 by main activity at end-2005, %

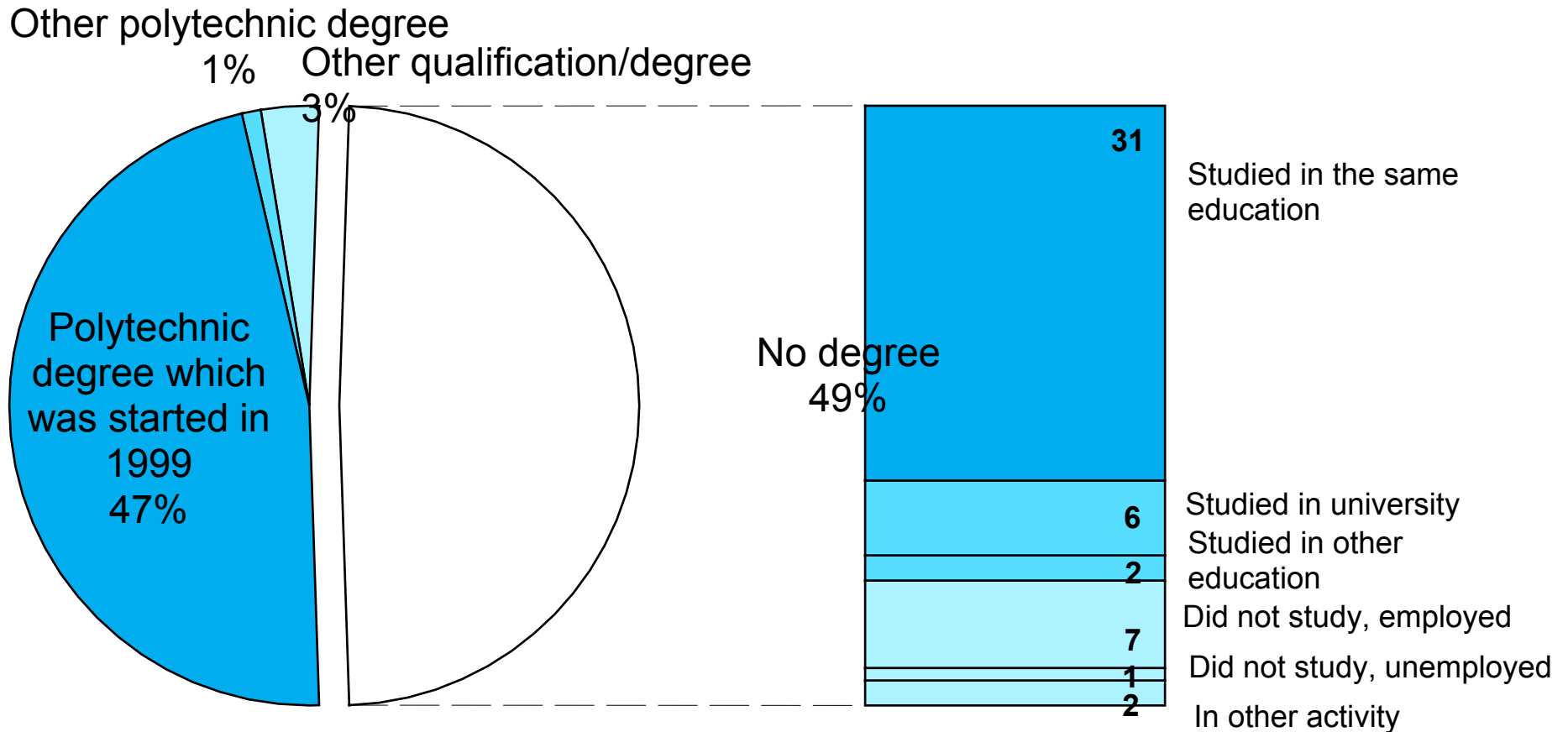
## Proportion of employed students during studies by sector of education 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004, %

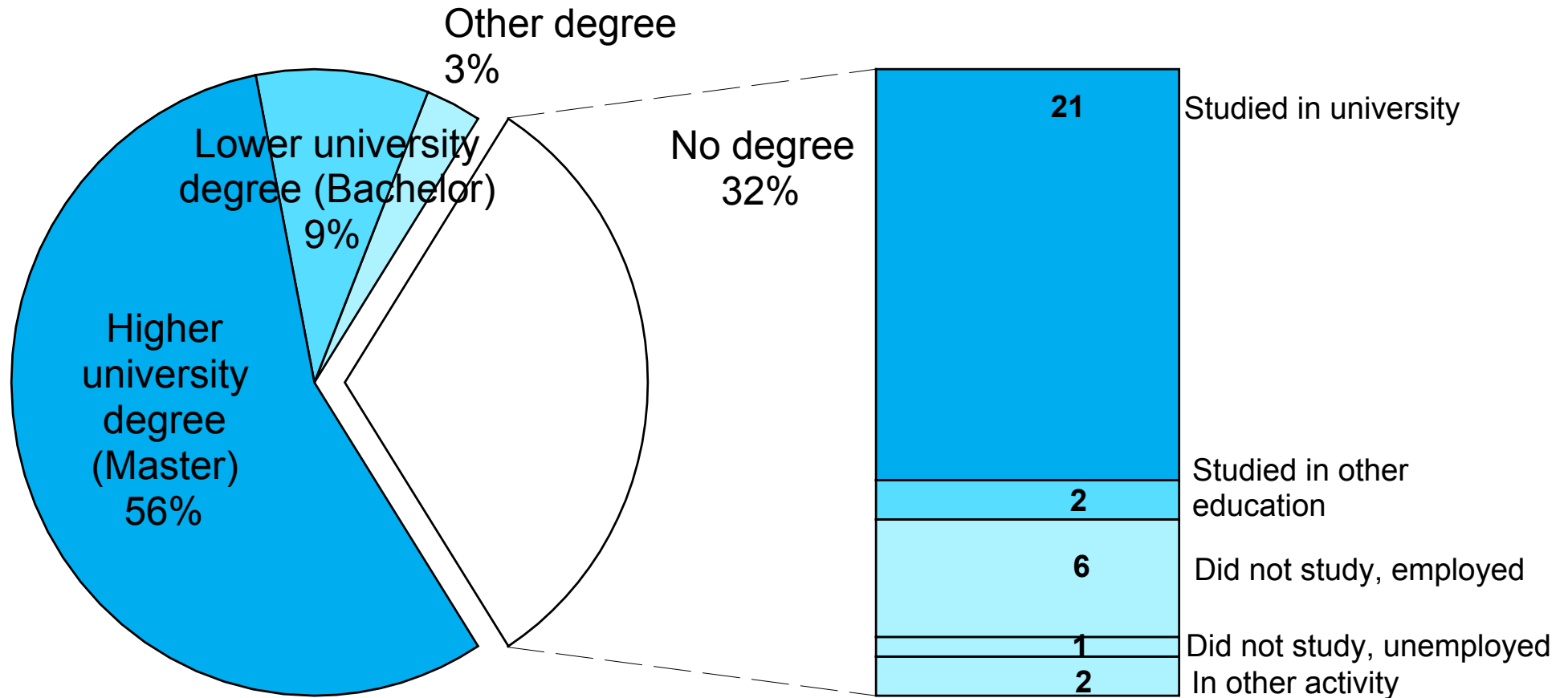
## Progress of studies in polytechnic education of those who entered education in 1999 by end-2003, %

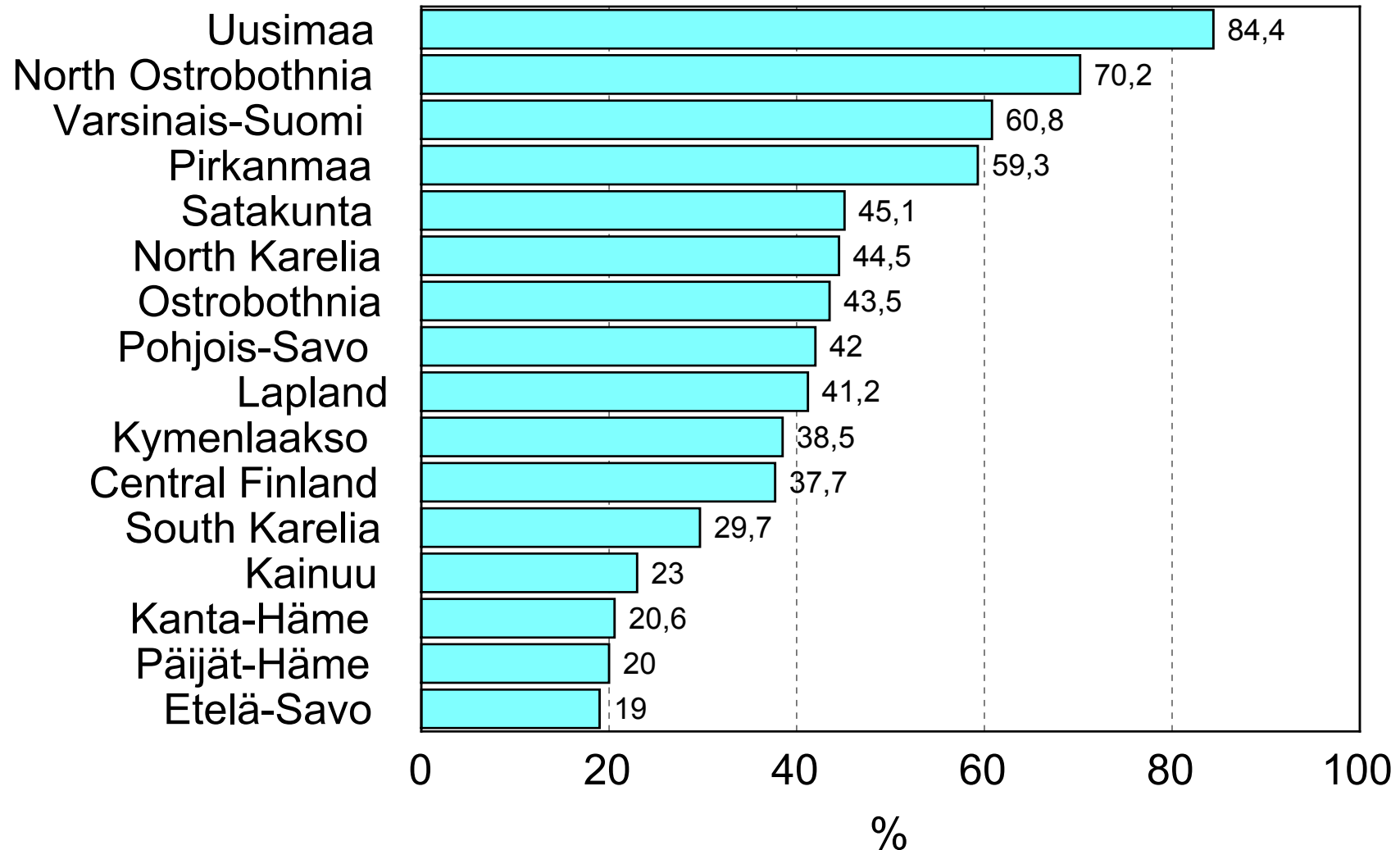
### Progress of studies in higher university programmes (Master's degree) of those who entered education in 1995 by end-2003, %

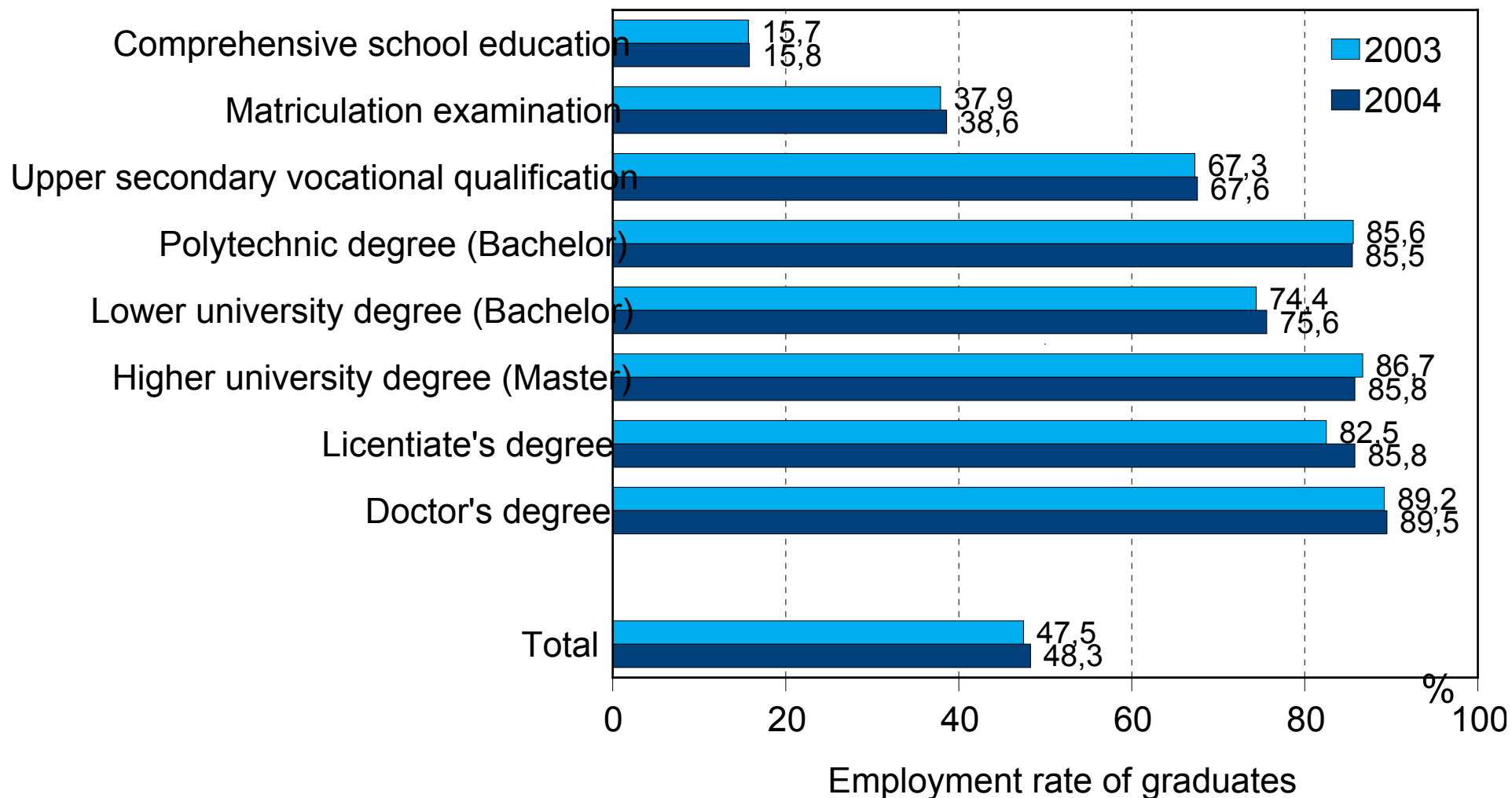


**Figure 8. The proportion of University graduates who's working area is same as the area of graduation in 2004**
